

COVID update as of Dec. 11, 2020

The provincial government has announced that York Region and Windsor-Essex County will be moving into the grey or lockdown stage on Monday, Dec. 14.

Seven other public health regions are also moving to new levels with stronger public health measures.

The announcement was made by the government in consultation with the Chief Medical Officer of Health, local medical officers of health, and other health experts.

Lockdowns last for a minimum of 28 days (but can be extended).

York Region and Windsor-Essex County are joining Toronto and Peel, which are also under lockdown.

RESCON expects the lockdowns in Toronto and Peel Region to be extended past Dec. 18 when the lockdown periods are currently scheduled to finish.
